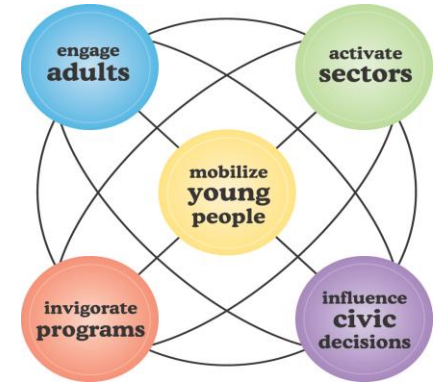

BACKGROUND

Clermont County's interest in Search Institute's 40 Developmental Asset framework first began in the eastern area in 2004 when Lead Clermont educated 73 stakeholders in the framework. This was followed by a pilot project in Felicity Franklin School District and the Felicity Initiative for Neighborhood Excellence (FINE) leading a grassroots initiative focused on building 3 assets of young people:

Asset # 8- **Youth as Resources**

Asset # 18-**Youth Programs**

Asset 33-**Interpersonal Competence**

In 2006, the Clermont 20/20 LEAD team convened a group of county stakeholders to identify strategies to engage young people. The vision emerged, "In Clermont County every youth thrives from investment by all adults and peers". Youth in attendance added the tag line, "Every youth, every day, do it all the asset way." In 2007, this group started calling themselves Clermont Asset Builders (CAB) and built a plan for how the regional and Clermont County Attitude and Behaviors survey results could be shared and acted upon.

September 17, 2008, CAB members held the event *Clermont Youth Speak: How Young People View Life in our Community* to share survey findings plus teen focus group results with citizens, organizations, schools. In 2009, CAB began planning the next steps in promoting the Developmental Asset framework. This workshop is the result of that planning.

PURPOSE

By working collaboratively to help children develop assets which predict positive outcomes and future success, this project will help to educate Clermont County stakeholders about the value and sustaining benefit of building Developmental Assets in our young people. This investment in the young people of Clermont County will help build responsible citizens and leaders for the future of our community.
